MONKTON SCHOOL (ISAIAH BAPTIST CHURCH) - 1873 - West side of Monkton-Manor Road, Monkton. This brick building was one of the standard vernacular style schools originally designed by Thomas Dixon and was designated School 10, District 10 in the 1873 report of the Board of School Commissioners. The contractor was Samuel Miller, chief businessman of Monkton. Original measurements were 45 by 24-½ feet and there were two rooms and a vestibule. In 1936 the Board of Education sold it for \$500.00 to Monkton M. E. Church, which used it as a meeting hall. In recent years, it has been used by Isiah Baptist Church, a black congregation which outgrew its old church on an adjoining lot.
