RUHL SCHOOL - 1879 - 2504 West Ruhl Road, Ruhl. Brick school 24 by 36 feet built on lot acquired in 1878 from Charlotte Palmer. "It replaces a dilapidated log house in which some of the present day system served an apprenticeship more than forty years ago," as reported by Board of School Commissioners report for 1879. Sold off by Board of Education in 1933 to Pierce Stambaugh. The old school was 150 yards away per recitation in deeds CWB JR. 1028:174.

The school commissioners gave most of their architectural work to Frank E. Davis at that time. The 1878 report stated, "To Charlotte Palmer, \$50 for one and a half acres near the old log building known as Ruhl's School house in the Sixth Election District. A handsome brick house will be erected here early in the spring, the building of which is under contract."

The minutes of the commissioners recorded October 17, 1888, an "order to rebuild School 6, District 6 burned..." (Vol. 5:21).
