- CA-2472 **WOODLAWN ABBEY (MAUSOLEUM)** - 1914-1916 - 2130 Gwynn Oak Avenue, Woodlawn. Classical, domed, marble mausoleum designed by the city firm of Mottu and White, architects. First advertised as "Woodlawn Abbey" by the Woodlawn Cemetery Company. See advertisement in Sun, January 2, 1916.
- BA-2473 **FENKER HOUSE** - ca. 1925 - 6830 Windsor Mill Road, Woodlawn. East of Holder Road. Magnificent, broad, 2-½ story, American Four-Square, colonial revival house in rock-faced concrete block, with prominently quoined corners. Dormers in each surface of the hip roof. Full-width and wrap-around porch. Well back from the road. Probably built by Herman J. Fenker, who acquired a number of lots in the Holder Park subdivision in 1925 for only \$1,000.
- BA-2474 **ZIMMERMAN-DUNN-CHILDS HOUSE** - Before 1850 - 2103 St. Luke's Lane, Woodlawn. Four-bay wide, primitive rural house with west half covered with composition shingles, eastern half in stone. Vernacular style. Full width front porch. Presents its gable end to St. Luke's Lane. Apparently the A. Zimmerman house on the 1850 Sidney map; the Dunn house on the District 1 plate of the 1877 Hopkins atlas; the Dunn house again in the 1898 Bromley atlas; the Childs house in the 1912 plat of the adjoining subdivision called Holder Park. It was on Lot 3 of the subdivision of Charles Durgin' in 1978 (Plat Book 47:58).
- BA-2475 **SMITH CEMETERY** - Before 1831 - SE corner of Nassan and Rona Roads, Woodlawn. Burial place of Nicholas Smith (1798-1873) and family. Smith was an agent on the Underground Railroad according to family traditions not revealed until the 1977 Woodlawn Bicentennial. The Bicentennial book held that he, as a cooper or master barrelmaker, was able to transport escaped slaves in newly crafted barrels and take them to the next safe-house, a location still not known. The cemetery was reserved to the Smith descendants when Daniel Smith sold the farm in 1885 (See Deeds WMI 148:398).
