

BEAULAH LAND - 18_____ - 6508? Crestwood Road, Idlewylde. Large frame house of Joshua Register, owner of a Baltimore city bell foundry. The house was formerly the center of an estate called Beulah Land, "Beulah" being a Hebrew word for "happy" that is only found in the King James Version of the Bible, not used in recent editions. Beulah Farm was advertised in the Baltimore County Union, April 27, 1907. The property was sold for development in 1911 and was subdivided into the neighborhood of Idlewylde. A fire reduced the main house to its present remnant.
