Savage Gambrel Roof House
Hillsboro
Private

Circa 1800

Located uphill from the Yoash House is a frame 1 1/2 story gambrel roof dwelling, which is an early structure but which has undergone numerous changes to its appearance. Its side walls are now covered with aluminum siding and the odd overhanging roof with corrugated steel. At each gable, the original pyramidal chimneys remain. The house, including its roof, is similar to the Eveland House in Hillsboro.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Savage Gambrel House is located on the north side of Md. Alternate Route 404 and is the second house east of Tuckahoe Creek in Hillsboro. The house has a gambrel roof, but the other architectural features of the house have been changed so that the date of build is hard to distinguish from the exterior.

The house is a one and one-half story frame structure with a three bay south facade. There is a central doorway with an enclosed one bay, one story entrance porch. Later 6/6 pane sash windows are in the other bays and an odd overhang has been created in the gambrel roof. Three 6/6 pane flat roof dormer windows fit under the secondary pitch of the gambrel roof. The house is on a brick foundation and has pyramidal brick chimney stacks with corbel caps on the exterior gable ends. The exterior has aluminum siding and corrugated tin roof. A small wing projects from the rear of the house. The interior has two rooms on the main floor, with the staircase in the living room, and two rooms above.


