This building is typical of "vernacular" dwellings of the late 19th and early 20th Centuries. It possesses a broad gable in the center of the facade of the two-story portion. The date 1916 and initials C. M. are recorded in its foundation. To the rear is a one and one half story section with gambrel roof which dates from around 1800. Its interior has been altered and the exterior covered with asphalt siding. It is an interesting combination of vernacular structures.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Lemuel Kinnamon House is located on the west side of River Road across from the intersection with Sunset Avenue west of Greensboro, Caroline County. It is a late nineteenth to early twentieth century farmhouse built in two sections.

The main section of the house is a three bay, two and one-half story frame structure currently covered with a wide width siding material. The east facade has a full length, one story porch with square posts and a molded cornice which repeats the cornice molding of the main section. There is a central doorway, and 2/2 pane sash windows with wood shelf lintels. The roof contains a board central gable with a 2/2 sash window. Small brick chimney stacks are interior end on both sides.

The rear section is one and one-half stories with a gambrel roof and 6/6 pane dormer windows. On the south side is an enclosed porch running the full length of the wing.

The owner states that there are no distinguishing characteristics on the interior of the Lemuel Kinnamon House. The foundation of the main section of the house is initialed "C.M. 1916." The rear section may be older.


