DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

North of Williston Landing stands a modernised dwelling overlooking the Choptank River. Adjacent the dwelling is an old brick dairy or meat house. It is about 10 feet square and about six feet tall to the ends of the rafters. A steep pyramidal roof rise above the whitewashed brick walls. A new tapered finial rises from the apex. On the west side is a door and on the north and south sides a small vent. Its interior shows no signs of smoke so it was either used for the storage of meat or as a dairy.


