**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Marydel Railroad Station is located on Maryland Route 311 approximately one and one-half miles south of Marydel, Caroline County. It is currently being used as the office for a junkyard.

The structure is rectangular, four by two bays with a hipped roof. It is constructed of frame and clapboard and is on a block foundation. The ornamental features of the station are the arrangement of the panes in the upper sash of the windows, the shaped rafter ends and a gable with ornamental framing on the west side of the roof. The west and south facades have windows in all of their bays, while the north facade has two entrances and two windows. There is a small brick flue on the north side of the roof ridge towards the east.




