The house is set back on a large lot enclosed by a well preserved wrought iron fence (manufactured by the Cincinnati Iron and Fence Co.). There is also a concrete hitching post on the front of the lot between the sidewalk and street.


This large and imposing house was constructed circa 1900 and contains elements of the carpenter Queen Anne style.
