<p>This is a very attractive brick structure of the early Federal period. The front of the structure is Flemish bond while the sides and rear are common bond. The house is four bays wide and two deep. All of the windows are 6/6 sashes and the door, which is the second bay from the left, has a leaded glass overlight. The A-roof of the house has a moderate slope. There is an enclosed chimney at each end wall of the house. There is a cornice along the front roof line made of three rows of projecting bricks. To the rear of the house is a very narrow ell which is 1-1/2 stories high and six bays deep. It is covered with beaded clapboard and shingle. Part of it may be older than the main house. There is one dormer on the roof and it is set down into the wall. The second story windows in the ell are "lie-on-your-stomach" windows.</p> <p>There is a round brick ice-house with a cone roof.
