This building, now burned and in ruins, is famed as the site of the old Bohemia Manor and the site of the birthplace of Augustine Herman, a personage of some local fame. The ruins which now stand do not appear to be very old. They seem to be the remains of a large brick 5 bay house, 2-1/2 stories high, with a brick 2-1/2 story wing, and a fieldstone 1-1/2 story wing. The fieldstone section may be older than the rest of the house, but this could not be ascertained through any visible evidence.

As an historic site, this property should be noted.
