4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO

This is a large composite house. The main house, which is constructed of brick is new. To its left are two old wings. The one immediately adjoining the main house is three bays wide and one room deep. It is 2 1/2 stories high with a steeply pitched A-roof. The windows on the first storey are 6/9, while those on the second are 6/6. There is an enclosed chimney on the left end of the house. This wing and the one to its left are of roughly laid fieldstone. The small wing on the left is a 1 1/2 storey two bay wide fieldstone structure with a very steeply pitched A-roof. It is of very rough fieldstone with an enclosed chimney on the left end. This wing may date from the early eighteenth century.

This house has been well-restored and is in excellent condition.
