4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO

This is a large fieldstone ~~farm~~ house which was built into the side of a hill so that the front basement of the house projects down enough to make a full story. The house is three bays wide and slightly deeper. It has capped by a high steeply pitched A-roof. The first story windows are 9/6 while those on the second story are 6/6. The front door is an old panelled one. There are corner quoins made of dressed granite which decorate the house. There is an enclosed stone chimney on the ~~left~~<sup>west</sup> end of the house. To the ~~right~~<sup>east</sup> of this house is a smaller 3 bay 2-~~1/2~~ story wing on a lower level. (Its first story corresponds to the basement level of the main house.) The roof of this wing extends out (like the roof on the Indian Queen Tavern in Charlestown, Cecil County) to make a two story covered porch. This is a very attractive and interesting house. Its shape is curious, having been built into the side of a hill. It has refinements, such as the corner quoins, not found in many of the stone houses in this county. It has been well-maintained and no apparent alterations have been made to its facade.




