4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO

This is a very refined composite house of log and fieldstone. The log section is three bays wide and one room deep. It has a central door and all the windows are 6/6 sashes. There is a ~~gentle~~ ~~slight~~ A-roof. The logs are laid German-style and chinked in between with plaster and stone. The stone is laid in a decorative herringbone pattern. The log is exposed on ~~the~~ ^{the south} wall, ^{beneath the porch} while the ~~other~~ ~~logs~~ ^{remainder is} are covered with clapboard. All the door and window frames have very nicely carved ^{double} moldings ~~of~~ ^{of} paired half-round design. The stone section of this house, now completely in ruins is a two bay wide 2-~~1/2~~ story wing which appears to have had a rather steeply pitched A-roof. There is a huge fireplace with a squared log lintel which is approximately ~~two feet square~~. It is a very massive and thick fireplace. The fieldstone used in this wing is nicely cut and neatly mortared.

~~It is possible that the fieldstone part of this house dates from the late eighteenth century while the rest of it is early nineteenth century in construction. It is an interesting and well designed house with many architectural refinements. It deserves preservation and rescue from its present ruinous state. The log construction is among the best seen in this county.~~
