4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC **NO**

215 E. Main St. is a three bay, three ~~story~~ story frame dwelling. The door occupies the east bay of the facade and the windows have 6/6 sash and paneled shutters on the first floor, 6/6 sash and louvered shutters on the second floor and 5/3 sash and louvered shutters on the ~~third~~ third floor. The roof has a slight pitch and the chimney is in the west gable. The single most important feature of the building is the one story porch which has cast iron supports and arch-like brackets with intricate geometric and vine designs. Also separate from the supports is a drop like cast iron molding hanging from the ~~edge~~ outer edge of the cornice, giving depth to the iron work. Beneath the gutter is a n ornate tin box connected to the down spout with the date 1865 painted ~~there~~ thereon. To the rear of the ~~of~~ building is a two story frame wing.


