

<p>221 E. Main St. is of the same date and general design as several of the other buildings in Elkton with the exception that it was a double dwelling (now apartments). It is 10 bays long and two bays wide and has a mansard roof. The brick is laid in all stretcher bond. There are segmental arches over the windows and 2/2 sash. The doors are located in the <del>first</del> third bay from each end of the building and are trimmed with pseudo-colonial millwork. The two outside bays of each side of the first floor are three part brick bay windows. Between the bay windows is a porch with decorative cast iron supports, brackets and cornice. The cornice of the house is made up of large square white blocks resting upon a brick brackets. In the mansard roof are six "A" roof dormers.</p>

There are bay windows at either end of the south wall, each with 3 windows. Between these bay windows is a wrought-iron one-story porch sheltering 2 doors and 4 windows. The second floor has 10 evenly-spaced windows. The third floor has 6 peaked dormers.
