

Elkton House (222 E. Main St.) is identical to 220 E. Main St. with the exception of a center door having sidelights, transom and shutters and the second floor shutters are painted white. The cast iron porch is of less intricate design than its neighbor, having circles, fleur de lys and ovals and vine-like brackets. It extends on two sides of the structure. There are ~~two~~ two story bay windows on east and west sides of the frame wing in the rear.


