

Cox Farm House is a two story, five bay long stone house, covered with stucco. The original part was three bays long by two bays deep and had a side entrance and hall. The entrance has sidelights and transom of the second quarter of the nineteenth century, which is presumably the first date of construction. There was then added another two bays, nearly the same size as the first section and this was covered with stucco so that the age difference is hardly discernable. The "A" roof has a slight overhang. This house is noteworthy because it is typical of the period and shows some later changes.

Cox Farm house is a 2 story, 5 bay long stone house, covered with stucco. The original part was 3 bays long by 2 bays deep and had a side entrance + hall. The entrance has sidelights + transom of the 3rd quarter of the 19th Century, which is presumably the 1st date of construction. There was then added another 2 bays, nearly the same size as the 1st section and this was covered with stucco so that the age difference is hardly discernable.
