

Two and a half story brick building at the ~~SE~~^{North} east corner faces north with ~~no~~ ship-windows downstairs while the lower west wall is closed off to make shelf space for a store. The second floor openings are 4 bays north by 5 west.

The roof has an unusual set of gables in a hip roof, set back from the eaves cornice, each with a pair of small windows light up the third floor. (see sketch)
