DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Carnegie Victorian House was built about 100 years ago. It is two stories and has a brick foundation. The first story is clapboard and the second story is constructed of wooden shingles arranged in patterns. The exterior is painted a light green. Between the two sections and separating them is a strip of molding. There are two brick chimneys on the north side of the house.

The facade of the house and half of the east side have a one-story porch. The northwest corner of the building also has a small one-bay one-story porch. The window sash is 2/2 on most of the windows but there is a great deal of stained glass. The front door has a stained glass in a transom. All of the shutters have been removed. The upper sash has stained glass border.

There is also a small pavilion with a wooden shingled roof. Rising from the center of this is a small spire.
