**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This building is a two-story farmhouse four bays long by two bays deep. It is rectangularly shaped and built of brick. There is an inside end chimney at each end. The facade or southern exposure has a one-story four bay porch. There are two entrances on this side of the house with a transom over them. One of the doors has four panels. The glass is old and the sash is 6/6. The house has a full cellar with stone foundation. The exterior has been painted white.

A near two-story wing extends to the north and is built of stone. The windows and door frames are pegged. The sash on the two-story is 6/3. There is an inside end chimney. A smaller stone building is connected to this and this entire wing could have been the original house.

The roof has asphalt shingles. There is brick work under the eaves that form a cornice. There are bricks with glazed ends in this construction.

A barn stands about 100 yards away and is in bad condition. It has dates marked on it of 1810 and 1900. The barn has a stone foundation.
