**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

A small farmhouse to the south of the Old Nottingham Road; it is two-and-a-half stories in height four bays long by two bays wide. The walls are constructed of stone and have been covered with stucco and white-wash. There is an inside end chimney at each end of the structure. The sash is 2/2 and the trim is plain. The gable roof has a box cornice and is composed of asphalt shingles. A one-story end porch is built on the south side of the house and a small wing extends from the northern wall of the home. The sash in the attic story is 3/3. In the east gable wall is a date stone with the date 1863.
