DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house on the southwest corner of George and Second Streets is a low two story frame structure covered with white weatherboard with blue-grey trim. There is a leanto porch on the street facade which has a turn-of-the-century porch with turned posts and balustrade and pierced brackets. Its roof is covered with raised seam tin. The main roof is covered with corrugated metal.

The facade of the building has a door on the outside corners. Between, are two windows with two windows above, all having 1/1 sash.

Behind the body of the dwelling is a two story wing with an enclosed leanto on its north side. On the west is also a small leanto. The latter two wings are covered with white asbestos siding.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The porch is an important element in the building. If this building is the same occupied by William Hunter in 1843, it has been altered or re-built since then as no trim exists from that period.

In October, 1843, John and Mary Ann Wise bought this house for one hundred and fifty dollars from John Smith and Mary Ann of Wayne County, Pennsylvania. At the time of this transaction, the house was occupied by William Hunter. This home is significant only as an example of the housing available for the families of men who earned their livings as boatmen.
