DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The sixth house south of Second Street on the east side of Charles Street is a two bay long, two story frame dwelling with two story extension on the rear and an enclosed leanto north of the latter extension.

The facade of the building has a shed roof porch, partially enclosed, partially screened. The entrance is located on the northernmost corner of the facade with two windows to the south. Two windows light the second story with their 2/2 sash. At the bottom of the raised seam 'A' roof is a scalloped eave board. An old chimney rises within the south gable and a newer brick chimney rises on the outside of the north gable.

The house is painted white with green trim, although in need of a new paint job.

Adjoining the property is a privet hedge to the north.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Lloyd House is typical of the two bay wide, frame dwellings on Charles Street. It lends a certain rythm to the street, besides retaining an attractive scolloped facia board, similar to the wharf property at the northern end of Bohemia Avenue.

Another of the simple working men's homes clustered near the street leading to the Canal. Charles Street has been home for the men who worked on the dredges, the tow boats, the old locks, and all the other tasks involved in keeping the channel of the Canal navigable and the traffic moving through the Canal.
