**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Hubis House is a two-and-a-half story brick structure three bays long by two deep. The bricks are laid in a variation of common bond. Every 13 rows of stretchers is a row of bricks laid in flemish bond. In each gable wall are two inside end chimneys one to each side of the gable roof. In the center of the roof is a pedimented gable with a semi-circular window. The box cornice is supported by brackets. Each window has a stone lentil and sill. The sash throughout is 4/4. The first story windows have paneled shutters and the second has louvered ones. The facade has a one-story wrought iron porch with a hip roof. The house has a slate roof. The foundation is stone with a cellar. On the east gable is a two-story bay window built of brick. There is also a small Victorian porch on the rear of the house.

In the past five years a modern rear wing has been added. Original lightening rods adorn the roof. The interior is in very good condition and remains in nearly original condition.
