DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Stafford Victorian House is a large two and a half story frame building covered with clapboard. This house is three bays long and two deep with a two story rear wing. On each side of the central bay is an interior stove chimney made of brick. The gable roof has slate shingles laid in a pattern. In the center of the roof is a peaked dormer with a "gothic" sash window. The roof also has early lightening rods with glass bulbs scattered across it. The window sash is two panes over two and there is no sign of any shutters on the house. The front of the house has a single story porch with a pedimented gable over the center of it. The porch roof is supported by Victorian posts with small brackets. Running between the brackets and lower edge of the roof is a grill composed of rectangular wooden elements (or sections). The rear wing has a small second story porch on its south side. The house has a stone foundation and cellar.
