**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Cogolin Stone Victorian House is a building whose windows affect the Gothic style. This house is two stories with an attic in height and is three bays long by two deep with a small two story rear wing. The exterior walls have been stuccoed but in places has worn off. The facade has a central bay entrance with a one bay entrance porch. The entrance doorway has a three light transom and the door has circle head panels on it. The gable roof has slate shingles and a centrally located peaked dormer. The roof has a box cornice with crown molding. There is an inside end chimney in each gable wall. Also, on the face of the gable walls at the attic level are a pair of lancet windows. The window sash is 6/6 throughout.

There are several small outbuildings on the property and a medium size bank barn of frame construction with board and batten siding.
