DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE		
<p>The Peoples Farmhouse is a duplex approximately three bays long by two deep. It is built of fieldstone with quoins in the corners of the walls. The house is two storeys in height with an attic. The gable roof originally had wood shingles, but this year had them replaced with asphalt shingles. The roof has a plain box cornice. Before the recent rennovation the roof extended over a storey and a half rear frame addition. This had a cat slide effect. This frame addition was built in the mid to late 19th century and was probably used as a kitchen. In each gable end of the stone section is a brick end chimney. The house has a stone foundation and cellar. The cellar entrance is on the west gable wall. There are arched fireplace supports at each end of the basement.</p> <p>Across the facade was a single storey front porch which also was removed. The only visible remains of the porch are the stone supports. The interior of the house has been altered. New sheetrock has replaced the earlier plaster and lath. Also there is new flooring and a raised hearth has been added to the large cooking fireplace in the west end of the house. This fireplace has a crane and a wooden lentil. The house has a central stair to the second floor.</p>

It has no original woodwork such as chairrail, etc. The house is important because it has served as a farmhouse for about 200 years. Also the house was built in a small valley which has not changed in appearance therefore the landscape or setting is of note.
