**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Nonn Log House is a two-story log house three bays by two. The logs are laid in saddle notch style. In the east gable end is a large stone chimney. Beside the first floor fireplace is an enclosed winding stairway built of board-and-batten construction. The beams of the first and second floor are exposed and reveal a bead on each edge. All doors are board-and-batten; one has strap hinges. The rafters are pinned and the roof is covered with wooden shingles. The flooring, which has been removed, was numbered. The windows on the first floor are 6/6 and on the second 3/6.

Behind the house is a root cellar.
