**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Providence Mill Manager House is a two and one-half storey house built in the Victorian style so common to houses of the late 1800's and early 1900's in Cecil County. It is three bays long by two deep with a rear two storey wing that has a one storey addition built on. The house has a gable roof which is covered with wood shingles. In the center of the roof is a peaked dormer. The facade has a central bay entrance and a one-storey porch which is supported by turned posts and and pierced brackets. The house has a brick inside end chimney in the north gable wall. The siding is still wooden and is like weatherboarding. The window sash are 1/1 with some paneled and louvered shutters on the first storey. This house has a stone foundation and cellar.

Behind the house is a small frame building with board and batten siding and a gable roof. It has been used as a garage.
