**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Lamonica House is a three-bay by two frame structure built in the late 1800's. The southern most bay has a two-and-a-half story "tower-like" one bay square section with a steep Gothic style roof. On the first story in the gable (south) is a one-story bay window with a mansard style roof. The attic window in the "tower" and the main part of the house is semi-circular shaped.

The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and has a Gothic-style dormer with the semi-circular window. The house has a stone foundation that has been stuccoed. A modern screened porch runs from the "tower" to the north gable. It is one-story in height.
