**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The McCauley House is a small one and a half storey building built of frame and stone construction. The house appears to have been built in three sections with the middle part of the house being the oldest part. The house is roughly three bays long by two deep. The western most two bays are built of stone with a covering of stucco. The eastern most bay is of frame construction with shingle siding. The chief entrance is in the central bay of the house which seems to be the original section. The house has an interior brick chimney and an exterior brick chimney on the east gable wall. The gable roof has a corrugated metal covering over what probably was a wood shingle roof. The window sash varies from 2/2 to 3/6 and most of the window sills are made of wood. On the facade is a single gable roofed dormer. The rear of the house has a small one storey porch. There was not an interior investigation.
