DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Gallagher-Eyans House is a two-story frame dwelling three bays long by two deep. In each gable end is an inside end chimney. The house sits on a stone foundation and cellar (all floor joists sawn). The framework of the house originally was covered with clapboard but now has roofing shingles nailed on top of the siding. The house has a central stairway but originally had a winding staircase beside the chimney in the eastern end of the house. The front door has a two-light transom over it. There are several board and batten doors and one four panel door all Victorian hardware.

Attached to the rear of the building is a two-bay by two shed addition.
