**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Childs Row #3 is a two story frame building very similiar to Childs Row @ #2. In fact the only major difference is that it is one half the size of #2 and is a single family dwelling. It is two bays across by three deep with a side bay entrance. On the other bay of the facade is a two story bay window-like structure with half timbering and diagonal design panels. A single story porch extends from the bay window across the facade and up the north wall. It is supported by turned posts and brackets. A small bay window is built over th porch along the north wall. The small peaked dormer like no2 is also on the roof above the two story bay window. In the south gable end of the roof is a brick inside end chimney. The window sash is 2/2 throughout. Surrounding the yard is a wooden picket fence.
