DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This mill dam was for the David Scott Mill downstream. It was built of local fieldstone in the early 1800's. The eastern and western ends of the dam are still visible and appear to be in good condition. The central portion of the dam was damaged in the last 10 years and has completely fallen down. The dam is about 125' long and 20' wide at the base while about 10' at the top. It was shaped like this---
