DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Lenhoff House is a frame farmhouse that dates from the early 1900's. It is built in the Victorian style. The house is 2½ storeys in height and is three bays long by two deep with a two storey rear wing. The house has a gable roof with a peaked dormer in the center of the facade. The roof has asphalt shingles. In the central bay of the facade is an entrance with transom and side lights. Across the front of the structure is a one storey porch. The window sash is two over two. The exterior of the Lenhoff house is covered with tile shingles. The house has a stone foundation and a cellar.
