## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Johnson Victorian House was built about 1898 on the site of an earlier building by John and Jethro Johnson. Much of the woodwork was supposed to have been milled in Baltimore and shipped by boat up the bay (See GEorge O. Stevens illustrated Price List of C. 1879). The house has a wide variety of architectural elements all of Victorian style. This frame building is two and a half stories in height and built in the shape of a T. The front section of the house is three bays long by two deep. The rear wing is two bays long by one deep. The exterior of the house is covered with poain weather boarding. The facade of the house is the most decorative part. Across the front of the house is a one story porch which has a central pediment in the roof which is in line with the dormer in the upper story. The porch roof is supported by large turned posts. In the center of the porch beneath the edge of the roof are a series of pierced facia with finials and a pair of gracefully ch
