RADEL DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The ~~RADEL~~ ^{RADEL} House dates from the first half of the 19th century. Log walls are all that remain of the earlier 2 story single room plan structure. The structure sits on a small rise that overlooks the Elk river. The house faces east with the main gable running north/south.

A larger 2 story frame section 2 bays across by 1 room deep was attached to the log section. A single story enclosed porch stretches along the south and east sides of the entire section. The house rests on a partial fieldstone foundation and is capped with a medium slopped tin roof. The exterior weatherboarding has been covered with aluminum. 6/6 sash window with plain trim are found throughout both sections.

The logs were visible on the north wall and the walls were the correct thickness. Corner notching could not be seen.

The interiors of both the log and frame sections have been remodeled extensively.

A common 2 story barn with vertical board and batten siding is found to the west of the main house.

The ~~Radel~~ *RADEL* House does not retain much in the way of existing architectural detail. The house is important since it is constructed on log with a later and very typical 2 story 2 bay by 1 room addition. The log house is hardly reconizable due to its alterations but definitely worthy of note. The house does appear on the 1877 Lake Atlas under the name of J. Clay.
