DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Fulton House is located on Old Conowingo Road just East of Route 222. The house is at the end of a long lane, which extends to the north of Route 222. The main facade faces south with the main gable running East/West.

The Fulton House is a mid to late 19th century ^{2 story} frame I-House three bays across by one room deep. A rear two story T addition, two bays across by 1 room deep, extends to the north. A single story shed porch is attached to the main facade.

Permission was not granted to do any more than a brief description. The house is not specifically important in itself but does remain as another example of the late 19th century I-House that was widely used in this area as with the rest of the state. The house does appear on both the 1858 Martenet Map and 1877 Lake Atlas. Whether the main block was there as early as 1858 could not be determined.
