The two mid 19th century frame houses on the property have been extensively remodeled and involved in resort development.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Reybold property c. 1860 consists of one 2½ story four bay by one room frame house (ce-938A) and a two story four bay by one room frame house (CE-938B) in what is now Elk View Shores along the Elk River, the two houses face each other with CE-938A having a southern exposure and the gable running north/south. CE-938B faces north with the main gable running east/west.

CE-938A has been remodeled extensively. A rear two story one bay by one room kitchen wing extends to the north, which has a block foundation. The main block foundation. The main block rests on a fieldstone foundation. Aluminum siding covers the original weatherboard. The sash were replaced when the house was remodeled in the early 20th century. A gable enclosed entry protects the front door. The medium sloped composition tile roof has a simple boxed cornice and is closed with simple bargeboards on the gable ends.

The interior has been generally remodeled but a third quarter of the 19th century stair remains. ^{The new post} has a octagonal central section with a flat oval handrail which is supported by turned balusters.

CE-938B is a smaller two story frame house across the lane and facing CE-938A. The main block is four bays across by one room deep with a 1½ story shed addition off the south side that continues the rear slope of the roof. The entire house rests on a stretcher bond brick foundation above ground level. The house is sheathed with composition tile and capped with a medium sloped tin roof. A boxed cornice and plain bargeboard decorates the eave. A later hipped roof porch covers the central bays of the first floor. 6/6 sash windows remain with plain trim.


