Although William Knight's own residence was on the southern shore of the Bohemia River, he owned an extensive amount of farmland south of Earleville and especially along the road to Fredericktown, now called Sandy Bottom Road. The traditional two and a half story five bay center hall house is not ^{VERY}~~much~~ different than all the others of the same type in the county.
