C. 1850-1870

This two story three bay frame house has had two close encounters with the County Road System neither of which caused its destruction. Interstate 95 passes directly south and the high embankment of Route 213 over shadows the house on the west. The two sectioned framed house is severly plain due to a sheathing of aluminum siding. One unusual feature of the property stands northeast of the house and is the fieldstone and brick chimney stack to a now non-existent slaughter house. The partially conical stack is laid in stone to a level height of fifteen feet where it continues for another four to five feet with a narrower square brick stack.




