Peeling painted bricks reveal the previous existance of a second front door in the main elevation of this two story common bond brick house along Little Egypt Road. The house ~~is therefore~~ belongs to the large group of northern county cross passage/two room plan houses. (See house form chapter) The builder was a David Garrett who appears on the 1858 Martenet Map and in County tax assessment records. Garrett was assessed for 23 acres and a "New House" in 1852.
