James Kilgore sold to John Willis, c^{arpenter} "....^{that}~~the~~ tract of land whereon he the said James Kilgore now resides, lying and being in Cecil County, being a part of land called and known by the name of Wallace's Scrawl... Beginning at an ancient black oak tree, on the west side of the road leading from Evans Rolling Mill to Cecil County poor house..." (JS 23/357 - March 2, 1826) The construction of the extant two story three bay cross passage two room house is attributed to either Kilgore or his immediate ^{successor}~~predecessor~~ Willis. The fieldstone structure is built into the eastern bank of a hill and typical of houses preferred by Scotch-Irish builders.
