DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Nichols-Allred house c. 1850-1875 is a two story three bay by one room frame house with two story two bay by one room ell kitchen wing. The house has been uniformly sheathed with aluminum siding and with composition tile shingles. The rear kitchen wing retains its standing seam tin roof. The house stands to the north of Nesbitt Road and just west of its intersection with Colora Road. The house faces east with the main gable running north/south.

The entire frame rests on a fieldstone foundation. A shed roof porch is attached to both the east and north sides of the house and is supported by chamfered posts with simple "C" brackets.

The eastern facade consists of a central entrance and flanking 6/6 sash windows on the first floor. Three 6/6 sash light the second floor. Each window has a pair of aluminum shutters. The front door is a replacement.

The north and south gable ends have single 6/6 sash windows to the right or left of the stove stacks. The original stacks have been removed above the roofline. An exterior block stack rises on the north wall. The kitchen wing extends westward and flush with the end wall. A side entrance is flanked by a single 6/6 sash and two 6/6 sash light the second floor. The interior end brick stacks remains in the gable end wall of the kitchen. A 1½ shed roof gable end addition primarily covers the end wall.

The southern side is similarly arranged.

The interior of the house was not seen.

The two story three bay by one room farm house with ell kitchen is a form found throughout the county. This particular house was owned by James Nichols in 1877. James Nichols appears on the Patron List as owning 52 acres near Colora. He seems to have settled in the area round 1852 after arriving from Philadelphia.
