Based on available information, the Crawford-Atkinson House, located on Lums Road just west of North East Creek in Cecil County, is eligible for the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The two story, four bay stone building is significant as a good example of first quarter 19th century middle class housing, indicative of the growth of Cecil County in this period. The design reflects Pennsylvania vernacular design influences. The stonework, brick accents and finely executed federal mantelpiece exhibit an unusual attention to detail and sophistication.

The former is a two-story, four-bay hall/parlor house described in equity proceedings as the "Mansion House . . . of stone, 34 feet by 20 feet, 2-1/2 stories; good outbuildings; conveniently located."






