**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

Buildings 15 and 16 are one-story frame structures located at the intersection of Lamb Lane and Davis Road on the grounds of the Susquehanna Job Corps Center (formerly Bainbridge Naval Training Center and Tome School for Boys) near Port Deposit, Maryland.

Building 15 is a one-story shed building with novelty siding and an open side facing northeast. Immediately east of the shed is Building 16, a more elaborate structure with a gable roof. This building also has novelty siding with the upper wall surface and gables covered with shingles. Double sliding doors in the southeast elevation give access to a carriage stall. A door in the north elevation leads to a small room probably used for harness storage. Both buildings have composition roofing. The carriage house roof is deteriorated near the front gable. The buildings are not currently in use.


