**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This two-story frame farmhouse is located on the northeast side of Davis Road on the grounds of the Susquehanna Job Corps Center (formerly Bainbridge Naval Training Center and Tome School for Boys) near Port Deposit, Maryland. It is partially ruined by fire.

The house has a central brick chimney and had a one-story shed porch which has collapsed. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the roof is modern composition material.

The interior of the house is deteriorated, but salvageable, since the fire damage is mainly confined to the second floor and southeast exterior corner.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The farmhouse designated Quarters BB by the Navy may have been built as early as 1875, although it does not appear on the 1877 Lake, Griffing and Stevenson Atlas of Cecil County. During its ownership by the Tome School, the house was living quarters for school employees. Under Navy ownership, it became officers' quarters.


