

Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The Cecilton Survey District is composed of 140 major resources lying along Main Street (Rt. 213), Bohemia Avenue and on Church, Wilson and Rickards Streets. The majority of the resources are residential, with two churches, a school and several commercial structures. Of the 140 resources, 103 contribute to the potential district; 37 do not contribute. Although a period of significance has yet to be identified, the district's resources date primarily to the late-nineteenth century and the early-twentieth century. A number of contributing commercial and residential structures date from the 1910's through 1950. There are only a handful of resources from the latter half of the twentieth century. Most of the contributing resources retain an high level of integrity, despite the widespread use of vinyl and aluminum siding.

Located on the western edge of the Cecilton Historic District, the Cecilton elementary school was constructed in 1939 with an addition in 1950. The two story brick building is significant for its association with the development of education in Cecilton as well as its architectural contribution to the historic environment. The massing, configuration and design reflect an influence of Georgian Revival architecture although modest in its application. The gable roof of the main block of the school (multi-purpose room) is sheathed in slate and adorned by an oculus windows. Concrete accents appear as coping, watertable and recessed panels above the elongated windows. The original windows have been replaced. In my opinion, the building possess sufficient integrity in its design, location, setting, material and workmanship to be eligible for the Maryland Register.
