DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Huckleberry Plains is a typical mid to late eighteenth century dwelling of frame construction, one and one-half storeys in height possessing double end chimneys.

The dwelling faces south and possesses an off-center door flanked to the southeast side by a single window of two over two Victorian sash. At the roof level, same elevation, are two large dormers also displaying late Victorian characteristics. Both dormers have six over six ^{pane}sash.

The north elevation, rear, has three windows at the first floor level and a large shed roofed dormer of early twentieth century origin.

The west end elevation has three windows at the first level and two at the attic level. A large exterior chimney is said to have existed here positioned off-center to the roof ridge and with its only known opening to be in the cellar. It was removed circa 1900 by the present owner's Father.

Two chimneys with free standing stacks and connecting one storey pent stands at the east end. The pent was remodeled some years ago and is now of frame construction overhanging the original brick base. Also to this end is a one storey frame building of probable late nineteenth century date.

The house is sheathed in rough planking, the south front has a late nineteenth century farm porch, foundations are brick with the chimneys bases laid in a Flemish bond, and the eaves are boxed with a shallow depth.
